# **Chains**

## Aim of the Program

This proficiency testing program aims to assess laboratories' ability to competently perform the prescribed measurements and analyses; and to provide participants with external quality assurance to enhance accuracy and reliability.

## **Application of the Program to Accreditation**

Participation in this proficiency testing program satisfies the requirements of ISO/IEC 17025:2017 – General.Requirements.for.the.Competence.of.Testing.and.Calibration. Laboratories.for monitoring performance by comparing results with other laboratories.

## **Program Details**

The Chains program is conducted annually and consists of one round per year.

Samples - One metal chain.

Tests – Breaking Load and Elongation

#### **Statistical Analysis:**

A robust z-score technique is used to assess performance.

#### Reporting:

At the conclusion of each round, each participant receives a confidential individual summary sheet, detailing its performance in the program, and a final program report summarising all participant data.

### Confidentiality

Each participant is assigned a unique code number, keeping all results anonymous in all PTA reports and publications.
